Graduate Program Online Admissions Requirement Checklist

1	Application Fee: \$100 (complete fee information see Enrollment Agreement)
2	Enrollment Agreement (all pages)
3	School Performance Fact Sheet for selected program (initialed and dated)
4	Official Transcript: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Provide Verification of completion of a Bachelor's Degree in the form of an official transcript of record from USDE recognized accreditation institution, and submit official transcripts from all other universities or institutions previously attended; completed and not completed.- Transcripts from outside the U.S. must be evaluated by a NACES approved organization. (Http://www.naces.org/members.htm)
5	Current Resume
6	Two Recommendation Letters: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Date / Signature of person / Title of the person- Letterhead (if cannot be provided have the contact information of the person)- MUST mention they recommend student for Graduate program at SSU
7	Personal Autobiography: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- In your OWN words, no internet sources / single-spaced essay of <u>at least 1000 words</u>- Detailing educational and work history, goals as they relate to educations and work history, and the relationship between these goals and future career aspirations- Must be submitted electronically (WORD)
8	Verification of English Proficiency: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- 80% on SSU English Proficiency Test- TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) Result of 61 or above on the IBT (Internet Based Test); 500 or above on the PBT (Paper Based Test)- IELTS (International English Language Testing Systems) result 5.0 or above- Have previously studied in a USDE-recognized accredited university level program, which was taught in English, for at least one quarter/semester, and maintained a minimum 2.0 GPA for Bachelor, 3.0 GPA for Master, for at least one academic term.
