(Htpp://www.naces.org/members.htm)</li> </ul>

6	Two Recommendation Letters:
7	<ul> <li>Date / Signature of person / Title of the person</li> <li>Letterhead (if cannot be provided have the contact information of the person)</li> <li>MUST mention they recommend student for Graduate program at SSU</li> <li>Personal Autobiography:</li> <li>In your OWN words, no internet sources / single-spaced essay of at least 1000 words</li> <li>Detailing educational and work history, goals as they relate to educations and work history, and the relationship between these goals and future career aspirations</li> <li>Must be submitted electronically (WORD)</li> </ul>
8	Verification of English Proficiency:
	<ul> <li>80% on SSU English Proficiency Test</li> <li>TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) Result of 61 or above on the IBT (Internet Based Test); 500 or above on the PBT (Paper Based Test)</li> <li>IELTS (International English Language Testing Systems) result 5.0 or above</li> <li>Have previously studied in a USDE-recognized accredited university level program, which was taught in English, for at least one quarter/semester, and maintained a minimum 2.0 GPA for Bachelor, 3.0 GPA for Master, for at least one academic term.</li> </ul>
